

'The Walk That Reconnects'

Are you a leader of the future?

We are looking for young people to take part in an exciting project where sustainability meets the arts in a life-changing opportunity.

The Walk That Reconnects takes place between 8th and 13th September in South Wales where we will walk the 56km of The Gower Way. This is an opportunity to connect with issues of deep ecology and sustainability with experienced facilitators and artists. The Walk That Reconnects offers participants an opportunity to consciously walk into a sustainable future together. Inspired by the ideas of eco-psychologist and activist **Joanna Macy** and '**The Work That Reconnects**,' it combines a multi-stage land journey, outdoor conference and walking workshop all in one event (more details attached).

We have six bursary places for young people to take part in this event. This means that we cover the costs of all food and camping for the duration of the walk, a fee towards mountain leaders, group facilitators, vehicle support and camp support team. (The bursary does **not** cover travel to and from the start and finish points.) Each person will be responsible for bringing their own tent/sleeping bag etc. A medical questionnaire and disclaimer must also be completed.

We are looking for young people who:

- Are aged between 18 and 25
- Are connected to issues of sustainability/activism and the arts in some way
- Have a desire to be a change agent of the future
- Are involved already in national or local sustainability/growing projects or campaigns
- Would benefit from being part of a supportive community of practice that the land journey will provide
